Project Outline

Our client came to us looking for ideas to improve their workplace environment. Based in a stunning London location with direct frontage to the Thames they felt their existing furniture didn't lend itself to the way they wanted to work and their people to feel.

During the consultation and planning stages we identified with building users the various types of spaces the footprint needed to provide to enable successful completion of day-to-day tasks and essential business activities.

Our team turned the inspiration into a phased programme of changes and improvements to the interior and furniture. This included provision for greater accessibility and inclusivity, the introduction of sit stand desks to encourage mobility, and much needed social, breakout and collaboration spaces for staff to come together and relax.

Key Outcomes

- 1200m2 workspace refurbished
- Minor works and decoration programme completed including painting, decorating services to freshen space
- Zero waste – existing furniture donated to charity
- Delivery and installation to timeline and budget
- Future proofing through flexible layouts
